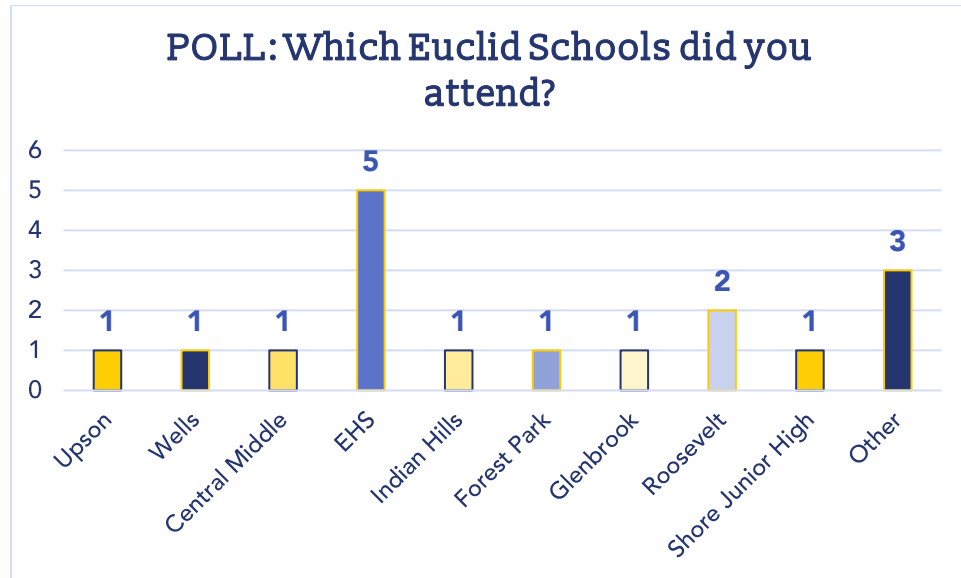

MEMBERSHIP UPDATE

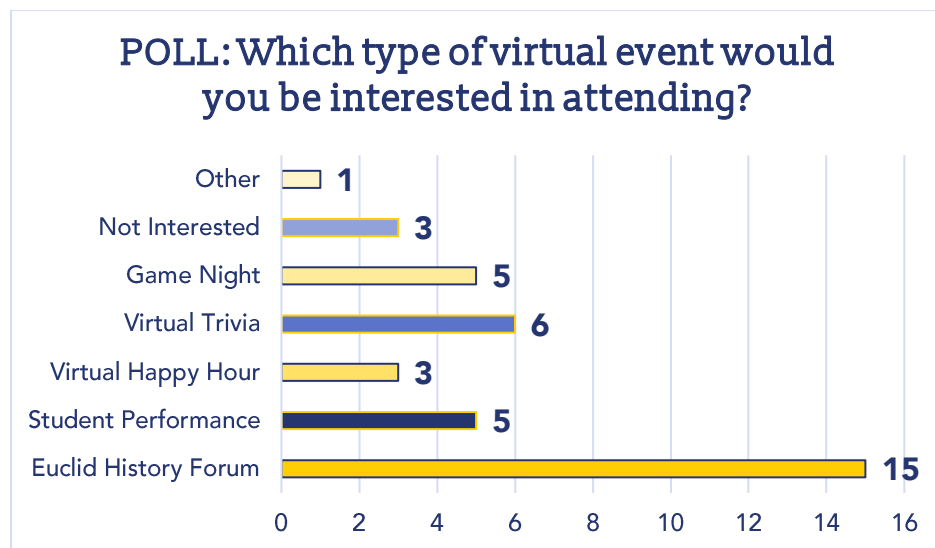
From Hal (Skip) Theis: Any idea how many Euclid HS grads and thus potential members?
