

EPSAA is seeking committed individuals to become trustees. Those interested in serving as a trustee should expect to:

- Lead a committee.
- Volunteer at EPSAA events—four per year plus the Sports and Distinguished Achievement Halls of Fame and occasional tables at school and community events and reunions.
- Attend approximately ten trustee meetings per year. Meetings are held monthly and last about two hours.
- Provide financial support where appropriate, for example as a patron of the Hall of Fame events.
- Use your expertise to work with the other trustees to meet the goals of EPSAA and advance the organization.
- Help plan and lead the Association Annual Meeting.

Before officially becoming a trustee, we recommend doing at least two of the following to see if it's a good fit for you:

- Attend a trustee meeting
- Join or lead a committee
- Join the Advisory Board
- Volunteer at an EPSAA event
- Join EPSAA at a table at a school or community event
